

In the process of implementing the procedures of adopting EU legislation, we began developing the EU portal in April 2003 as part of the Government Information System. The purpose of the EU portal is to facilitate the work of taskforces and ministries in preparing positions of the RS for individual legislative proposals in the EU. The system is set up to give an overview and allow integration of work on individual documents for taskforces which involve expert members from different ministries and government agencies. The system is connected with the Government Information System so that documents passed at government level are approved by the secretary general or his authorised deputy. The broader EU Portal concept also involves Slovenian representatives in Brussels and at embassies. One of the most interesting tasks involved in developing the system will be establishing a connection between the systems of the National Assembly and the Government Information System via the EU Portal.

Let's build the new e-administration portal together

The most concrete novelty in the new e-administration portal is that we managed to emphasise the connection to citizens, corporations and of course public administration employees. By taking into account many opinions, criticisms and suggestions, the e-administration portal becomes richer every day and more in the hands of the people it is meant for.

The operator also managed to successfully implement the e-employment public data announcement application. Great attention was paid to supplying an enormous amount of information through so-called life-events. These were divided into individual elements, themselves structured into sublevels, meaning that each life-event is broken down in detail. The ordering of different datasets is also very efficient... not to mention the personal adaptations, multilingualism, and support for those who are less able. Anyone requesting public hearings for material finds a real collection point for opinions and suggestions in the e-administration portal. WAP access (accessibility of the portal from mobile phones, handhelds and laptops...) was also not forgotten. We created a special adapter to specifically allow access to the portal through public access points and information kiosks. According to Dr Pavel Gantar, we successfully created one of the best portals on a world scale, an opinion which he voiced publicly. It is also thanks to achievements like the e-administration portal that we can take our place with ease alongside the other European Union Member States.
